Ashley Lucht called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM.

## 1. Welcome and Public Comment

Ms.Lucht asked if there was any comment from the public for items not on the agenda but there was none.

Miller was present to videotape the meeting for MMCTV Channel 15.

### 2. Reorganization

## Nominations for Selectboard Chair

Ms. Lucht nominated Chris Granda for Chair, and was seconded by Mr. Sander. Mr. Granda said this would be his fifth and final year on the Selectboard, and although the chair shouldn't be inflicted upon the freshman members, he would serve if he was not on the Water Commission.

Mr. Sander said he did not have the experience or time to serve as Chair, and Mr. Hill said the same was true for himself.

Mr. Yeates said he did have the time to commit to the Chair but not the Water Commission.

Ms. Lucht said she had no interest in serving as Selectboard chair.

Mr. Sander said he was not opposed to serving on the Water Commission.

The Manager asked if there were any other nominations. Mr. Hill nominated Taylor Yeates for Chair, 38 and was seconded by Mr. Granda.

There being no further nominations, the vote was called.

42 For Mr. Granda, the vote failed at 2-2-1 with Ms. Lucht and Mr. Sander voting in favor, and Mr. Granda and Mr. Yeates voting against, with Mr. Hill abstaining. 43

For Mr. Yeates, the motion carried 2-1-2 with Ms. Lucht voting against and Mr. Sander and Mr. Hill abstaining. There was some discussion. The Manager believed the vote carried in favor of the motion, even though less than a majority voted in favor. Some members of the Selectboard disagreed. By consensus, the Selectboard agreed to new nominations for Chair.

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Mr. Hill nominated Taylor Yeates for Chair and was seconded by Mr. Granda. There being no further nominations, the vote was called. The nomination carried 4-1 with Ms. Lucht voting against.

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Nominations for Vice-Chair

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6 Mr. Granda nominated himself for Vice Chair and was seconded by Mr. Hill. There being no further nominations, the vote was called. The nomination carried 5-0.

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Administrative Appointments

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Mr. Granda offered a motion to appoint the Manager, Geoffrey Urbanik, to serve as Board Secretary and was seconded by Mr. Sander. The motion carried 5-0.

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Mr. Hill offered a motion to appoint as official newspapers, the Burlington Free Press and the Times Ink! and was seconded by Ms. Lucht. The motion carried 5-0.

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Ms. Lucht offered a motion to appoint Mark Sperry, of Langrock, Sperry and Wool, as Town Attorney and was seconded by Mr. Hill.

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- Mr. Granda said that the town certainly has need of a town attorney and he had no experience with any except Mr. Sperry. However, there needed to be some criteria to assess the performance of the Town
- 43 Attorney. He felt that in certain instances where Mr. Sperry was asked for a legal opinion, it had
- 44 changed over time.

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Mary Houle appreciated that Mr. Granda had said that, and believes that Mr. Sperry had reversed two of his opinions. What did he charge per hour? It could also be expensive to switch.
