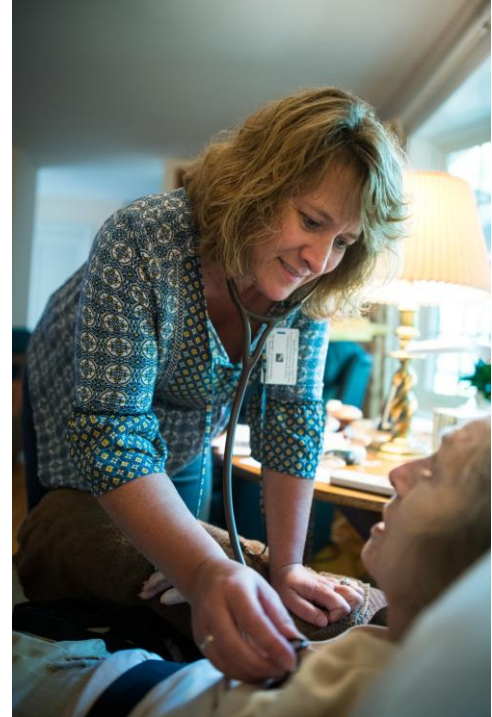

Home Health & Hospice in Richmond

- In our last reporting period, HHH provided care for **84 Richmond residents**.
- We provided those residents with over 1,400 visits AND over 80 hours of care (hours and visits are unique)
- Services provided in Richmond include: physical therapy, social work, nursing... and more!
