Notes from Dowd application: Applicants were sworn in and opened by explaining the proposal is for family and is located on an abandoned and leveled borrow pit. Much discussion on the deed language and the need to clarify proportional shares with concerns to the ROW and Wastewater proposals. Large animal habitat should be noted as well and wetlands permit to be submitted. Board raised the issue of the required masterplan for remaining lands and what notations would be required. Public comment from neighbor Anne O'Brien in support of the proposal. Hearing closed and board has 45 days to render a decision.
