This is a letter indicating my willingness to continue serving as an Alternate member of the Richmond Development Review Board. It has been my pleasure and interesting experience to serve the Town of Richmond as a member of the Planning Commission (1981-1990 and 2017 to present), as well as the Conservation Commission from 1992 to 2016. I have been an Alternate member on the Development Review Board for the past two years.

Being a native Vermonter born in Montpelier, Richmond has been my home since 1968. I am a career educator, having taught in local area public schools and the University of Vermont. Currently, I teach violin and piano at my Huntington Road music studio and own and operate Alison's Aquatic School.
