This is a letter of application requesting reappointment to the Richmond Planning Commission. It has been my pleasure and interesting experience to serve the Town of Richmond as a member of the Planning Commission (1981-1990, and 2017 to present), as well as the Conservation Commission from 1992-2016.

Being a native Vermonter born in Montpelier, Richmond has been my home since 1968. I am a career educator, having taught in local area public schools and the University of Vermont. Currently, I teach violin and piano at my Huntington Road music studio and own and operate Alison's Aquatic School.

I hold the degree M.S. In Natural Resources Planning and helped to write Richmond's first Town Plan, which was a graduate research project of a colleague at the University of Vermont in 1981. Last year, I worked on the subcommittee of the Planning Commission which revised the current Town Plan, leading to its passage by public vote in November of 2018.
