I was having a friendly conversation w/ Janet (owner) & dog Oakley attacked me suddenly, unprovoked. We were on my property but we welcome Janet + her grandsons to swim in that part of the brook where we've set up a sitting area + "pool" in the creek. Oakley attacked my arms + legs + left bites on all.

- We have had numerous instances where Oakley has been aggressive toward members of our family as we go down our driveway - both on our part of the driveway & on the right-of-way we have through Janet's drive. He growls + charges + nips at peoples heels (my son on his bike) but until yesterday didn't get a hold of anyone.

- We have a very pleasant relationship w/ Janet.
 - We have about 25 kids ages 4-15 coming to our land for "forest school camp" every day next week. July 5-9 all day. It is not feasible for the dog to be anywhere on the property during that time as he's a danger. These kids also come once a week at other times and I have had kids living here all the time. If these bites I have had been on a child's arm it would be broken; or their faces it could permanently scar or maim them.
