Position Statement of the Richmond Water Resources Department

Purpose and Priorities of a Water Dept

- 1. Protect Public Health and the Environment
- 2. Obey State and Federal Law
- 3. Abide by and enforce the ordinances and directions of the Water & Sewer Board/Commission
- 4. Provide the best possible customer service

Purpose and Nature of the Superintendent

- 1. Uphold the priorities of the Water Department
- 2. Act as the professional caretaker of the Water District
- 3. Be the active authority and decision maker on behalf of the Water and Sewer Board/Commission

Notes

- Powers, within the bounds of the Water District and the Water Dept, should be considered broad and general, unless restricted by the Water and Sewer Board/Commission
- I.E., Authority is *not* limited to what has been explicitly given by the Town to the Superintendent.
- Flexibility in the use or discretion of authority is vital to the smooth, adaptable, and strong function of a small Water Dept
- A Superintendent is subject to the *general* control and direction of the Water and Sewer Board/Commission; and has control, supervision, and authority, over the Water District
