Re: Arborist selection for tree removals and pruning around the library

I recommend that Richmond hire Acer Tree Company for upcoming work around the library and elaborate on this decision below.

Beginning in fall 2024, I solicited and received four bids associated with tree work around the library, focusing initially on pruning and removals on the northside of building. This work has since been extended to include pruning and one removal on other sides of the library to accommodate upcoming renovation and painting of the building. All bids are appended. Please note that the totals across these bids are not directly comparable, as some include more tasks than others. For example, the Limberwalker bid (received Aug 2023) includes only three tasks whereas SavATree and VT Tree Service (both received Dec 2023) include additional pruning that the arborists at these companies advised. Finally, the Acer Tree Company bid (received February 2024) encompasses the most work, including on other sides of the library. Even with those additional tasks, the Acer bid is the most economical. Other criteria guiding my recommendation include:

- International Society of Arboriculture certification: Acer, Limbwalker, and SavATree have this certification; VT Tree Service does not yet.
- **Timely availability for carrying out work:** Acer has affirmed their availability to carry out this work in advance of scheduled renovations and painting of the library by Hunger Valley Construction.
- Locally-owned company: Acer, Limberwalker, and VT Tree Service are all local companies; SavATree is not.
- Coordination with other contractors: Coordination with Hunger Valley Construction will be necessary to ensure that pruning is carried out in a manner that can accommodate renovation and painting equipment (eg a lift). Individuals at Acer and Hunger Valley have an existing working relationship.
- Professionalism: All companies I engaged with were professional and highly communicative. Acer, in
 particular, presented their Certificate of Insurance immediately, provided a quote in very short order,
 and fully elaborated on the rationale behind various tasks (eg black cherry removal; see additional
 considerations below).
- Total price: As noted above, the Acer quote entails the most work and yet will cost the least.

There are two additional considerations that will affect the final price: Acer notes that pruning the large sugar maple atop the stonewall is not at all pressing; removing that task from the scope of work would reduce the price by \$500 to \$2500. However, Acer does advise removing the black cherry on the north-side of the building given a rotting seam; this would increase the price by \$875. These two modifications would bring the total quote to \$3375, which still remains the most economical of the quotes.

In conclusion, I advise hiring Acer Tree Company to carry out this work around the library. I might suggest allocating funds not-to-exceed \$5000 for this work, in case additional pruning or removal needs arise once renovation and painting work commences (or if we elect to proceed with pruning of the large sugar maple atop the stonewall). Thank you for inviting me to take a look at the library trees yesterday. It was great speaking with you!

A proposal for the work we discussed is included below for your review. I would like to only send 2 workers and keep it at \$2,500, but the Sugar Maple prune on east side of building atop the stone wall is putting us over and we would need a third worker in order to get the job done in a day. It's a big tree and would take time to be pruned properly. If budget is tight, I would recommend holding off on pruning the Sugar Maple. It is perfectly healthy as is, and pruning is not pressing at all. If you would like me to remove from estimate, I will amend and resend at \$2,500.

Lastly, see attachment image of compromised Black Cherry on North side that is threatening building. Acer recommends full removal at +\$875. I can amend estimate if you would like to add this removal service.

We are happy to leave firewood on site if wanted. Chips as well?

When looking at the library from road, left side of library (woodline) needs to be addressed.

Box elder, hickory, and cherry- Prune back from building. We will be providing 8-10ft of clearance to allow more air flow to building.

Removal of a couple lower scrub trees and brush will also be done to allow a bit more airflow.

Remove 5 dead/ dying ash trees.

Removal of larger dead sugar maple.

Large sugar maple- located left side of property as well and above stone wall. Structural prune. We want to open up the main stem to accelerate growth and subordinate larger codominants. Removal of any 1" and larger deadwood. The idea is to make this tree more appealing visually by thinning and pruning while also providing more safety for the surrounding.

Two red maples- located parking lot side of library. Prune away from building (8-10 ft.) Cedars- left side of library. Slight raising and pruning back to open up pathway more.

Location of plant material is from the perspective of main entry point and targets (trees and shrubs) are oriented in a clockwise direction.
