-approve work scope for FOTW project - Walked Cat/Dog, Feel the Bern and Lung Ta and identified where to focus the work.

- discuss rivershore trail needs and create a trail plan - put two bridges back and flag a trail for a work day on May 14th.

- approve plan for updating trail conditions - Hannah looked into Trail Forks and RMT Trail Condition update system. The group discussed the pluses and minuses of both systems.

- approve plan for managing/communicating trail work needs - wait on this as we are in discussion about what platform for condition of trails.

- discuss landowner agreements/where documents stored - Alison checked with Josh Arneson and Linda Parent. They are looking for them. MOUs (Memorandum of Understanding) are used between towns and private landowners - discussed doing this with the landowners where our trails are located.
