

Dugway Rd. In Richmond, Vermont to Remain Closed to Through Traffic Until Washout is Repaired

RICHMOND, VT: Dugway Rd. suffered a partial collapse due to the rain event that occurred on Oct. 31 – Nov. 1, 2019. The washout took out approximately 60' x 10' of the north east bound lane. This occurred at about the center point of the road, approximately 1.5 miles from either end, near the Huntington Gorge. There is a vertical drop from the roadway to the gorge of about 60 feet. Residents are cautioned to avoid this area of the road as the site is unstable and more of the roadway may continue to fail at this location.

Town officials are working on getting this repaired as quickly as possible, but do expect the road to be closed for at least two months while repairs are made.
