

WARNING

The legal voters of the Town of Richmond, Vermont are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Richmond Town Center, 203 Bridge Street, in the Town of Richmond on Tuesday November 5, 2019, between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) in the forenoon (a.m.) at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the evening (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following article of business:

ARTICLE 1

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of the Town of Richmond in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000), subject to reduction from the receipt of available state and federal grants-in-aid, and payable out of water system revenues, be issued for the purpose of increasing financing by Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for the cost of replacing water lines on Bridge Street? This project was initially approved by voters on March 6, 2018 for a total of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000). The aggregate estimated cost of all such improvements being Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000).

The legal voters of the Town of Richmond are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said special meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

The legal voters of the Town of Richmond are further notified that an informational meeting will be held on November 4, 2019 at seven o'clock (7:00) in the evening, for the purpose of explaining the proposed improvements and financing thereof, to be held at the Richmond Town Center.




