Parking Plan for Bridge St. Infrastructure Project As of 4/28/20

This is a parking plan for use during the Bridge St. Infrastructure Project.

• 24 Hour Parking Relocated

- o Removal of the eight 24 hour parking spaces in the Depot St. lot
- Addition of eight 24 hour parking spaces in the Town Center lot, located in the backright section of the lot, near the post office.

Signage:

- Replace the current "Municipal Parking Signs" with new signs that will be brighter and incorporate the universal "P" that stands for Parking. The idea is to visually change the signage for parking in an effort to draw attention to the location of municipal parking lots with a goal of increasing awareness and usage. The signage will be changed for the following lots:
 - Depot St.
 - 27 Bridge St. (lot between the Greensea building and the old Toscano's building.)
 - Town Center
 - Volunteers' Green
- o Add "More Parking X ft. ahead" signs just to the north and south of the Depot St. lot.
- Please note that these lots will still be 2 hour parking.

Depot St. near the Richmond Food Shelf

 Designate the two spaces closest to the Bridge St. end of Depot St. as 15 minute parking. This will allow for customers of the Food Shelf or other businesses to be able to more easily find parking close by for a quick stop into a shop.

Due to traffic and demand for parking being low due to the "Stay Home. Stay Safe." Order, the following changes will not be made at the start of the project. If traffic and demand for parking increases during the project the following changes will be made as needed.

• Browns Court

 Rope off the eastern end of Brown's Court to allow for parking. Work with business owners to have them use this as parking for employees.

• Volunteers' Green:

O Add a divider in the center of the lot to better delineate how cars are to line up in that lot.
