Collaborate with the Trails Committee to:

1. Ask RTC to identify Trailforks at their webpage

https://www.richmondvt.gov/boards-meetings/trails-committee as the 'go-to' site for trails systems information, if that is the case.

Question: Does RTC need to create a paid account with Trailforks? (The links to www.Trailfinder.info should be retained, and possibly updated).

- 2. Identify a person responsible for updates of the ACF trails at Trailforks (Jim Cochran?) Remove permission of others who have entered/updated information on ACF trails, identify our responsible person as the contact person for updates, trail reports, trail photos etc.
- 3. Create a Trailforks trail system called Andrew Community Forest and include the following (renamed) trails (tracks look OK). Consider adding ACF to Trailfinder.info
- 4. Rename Trail names at Trailforks
 Parking to Power -> Access Road
 Mountain View (stet)
 Urbanik Way (stet)
 Fields Road to VYCC -> Former VAST Trail
- -> Specify permitted uses of each trail i.e. Bike, Hike, Ski, Snowshoe.
- -> Ensure consistency with the trails map at the kiosk (and that map to be posted elsewhere).
- -> Address shared responsibility of VAST trail with Maple Wind?
- 5. Ask RTC to add ACF Trails to the RTC webpage at https://www.richmondvt.gov/boards-meetings/trails-committee

Incidentally – ask RTC to update their Trailforks entries at https://www.trailforks.com/region/richmond-1454560310/ridingareas/ to correct the name "Richmond River Trail" to "Warren and Ruth Beeken Rivershore trail".
