To whom it may concern,

This is an overview of the application for 30 Bridge St. In an effort to create a safe dining experience for our patrons as we come out of the global pandemic we decided to replace our existing windows (which do not open) with operable units to allow for more fresh air to enter our establishment. After exploring all options we decided that roll up windows would allow for maximum air exchange. Upon meeting with the ZA to discuss the replacement project I was under the impression that window replacements do not require permits and as such went about the exchange.

After completing the installation the ZA indicated that this was a façade change and as such I would need drb approval. The first replacement of these windows occurred 6 years ago. At that time, we went from a single pane to a double pane and that process did not require a permit.

We used black framed, 6 panel windows to match the existing color of the façade and took great care, as we always do, to enhance our building with this selection. We have received abundant compliments from the public as well as from our patronage. We used the existing rough openings for the new windows.

I have included pictures of the before and after. These pictures are several years apart.
