Richmond Planning Commission Regular Meeting Wednesday, January 21, 2015 Unapproved Minutes

No quorum for official meeting.

General Conversation

Jeff Forward was present and voiced concerns over changes to the Gateway and the potential completion with the Village. And the lack of a comprehensive planning process in over 20 years.

Discussion followed about the previous evenings Selectboard which included a discussion on the gateway. Rock, Cousins and Forward were present at the Selectboard meeting. Rock provided an overview of what changes the Selectboard proposed, they included changing the parking proposal within section 3.4.5 a) so not allow any parking in front of the building which sits closest to Route 2 on any lot. They added the following sentence to 3.4.5f)ii "roof top equipment shall be screened from view from RT 2." And proposed the following for section 3.4.5 f)iv "structures shall have the appearance of wood or brick."

The SB will make their draft available to the public and have not scheduled a public hearing date yet.

Rock reported, last night the Selectboard also held the public hearing on the Flood Hazard Overlay District regulations. There were no comments and the SB approved the changes.

 Rock will be submitting a couple of requests to *CCRPC's Unified Planning Work Program* (*UPWP*) *Request*, where CCRPC may fund town projects as part of their annual work plan. Richmond will be requesting a Transportation Plan to be completed which will serve as the Transportation element of the new Town Plan. Richmond also requested for technical assistance and support for the upcoming Town Plan process.

Regarding the Town Plan process, a RFP has been issued and we'll have consultants proposals ready for the Feb 4 PC meeting. WE hope to have a consultant on board by early March. We've received interest in the Steering Committee, Rock distributed a list of people which have expressed a willingness to service on the committee to date. The Steering committee will meet before each PC meeting so it will give committee and board members to attend both meetings.

 Both Cousins and Forward suggested following up with the Orton Foundation, especially Leanne Tingey, and to look at Orton's Heart and Soul process for Richmond's Town Plan process. Rock has participated is one of their recent webinars and plans to use their Field Guide as a guide for the public participation component of the Town Plan process.
