The Richmond Conservation Commission recommends approval by the Selectboard of the March 6, 2020 application from the Richmond Land Trust for funding to support a Swimming Hole Steward Program for the summer of 2020, in the amount of \$1,500, including consideration of the delay in repairs to Dugway Road. Reasons for recommending approval include consistency with Conservation Reserve Fund criteria, including Criteria 1-4 and 7; and because of significant positive impact on enforcement of regulations, safety and education regarding the Huntington River swimming holes, and the gathering of user information important to guiding their future use. RCC also recognizes substantial cost-share.

The Richmond Conservation Commission recommends approval by the Selectboard of the application from the Vermont Land Trust involving the Peet Farm, presented at the March 10, 2020 RCC meeting, for \$20,000 of CRF funds. Approval is based on consistency with Conservation Reserve Fund criteria with regard to protection of agricultural resources, natural and historic resource protection. RCC also recognizes significant cost-share. Approval is recommended for three years from the date of final approval and is renewable.
