

October RCC Meeting Motions

Motion Beeken Preserve 10/12/21

The Richmond Conservation Commission recommends approval of up to \$2,500 in Conservation Reserve Funds to cover the cost of an Engineering study to resolve parking and erosion issues at the Beeken Preserve on Cochran road, as described in the Richmond Land Trust proposal dated 9/21/21. The request fits a number of CRF criteria, as enumerated in the proposal related to providing access to and preserving recreational opportunities, conserving an important natural resource. If approved by the Selectboard, we recommend a sunset date of 10/12/2024.

Motion Overackers 10/12/21

The Richmond Conservation Commission recommends approval of up to \$2,500 in Conservation Reserve Funds to cover the cost of a wetlands Delineation for Overackers Park, as described in the Richmond Parking Advisory Committee proposal dated 9/13/21, and as has been required by the Chittenden County Department of Environmental Conservation Management Division. The request fits a number of CRF criteria as enumerated in the proposal, including access to recreational opportunities. If approved by the Selectboard, we recommend a sunset date of 10/12/2024.

Motion Lake Iroquois Plant Survey 10/12/21

The Richmond Conservation Commission recommends approval of \$1,000 in Conservation Reserve Funds to cover the cost of a plant survey as described in the application received from the Lake Iroquois Association for its review at the 10/12/21 RCC meeting, contingent on adequate funding for the project. There is a 2:1 cost-share match from Lake Iroquois Association funds together with a request to the Town of Hinesburg. The proposal matches several CRF criteria related to natural resource protection including A.1, A.5, B.1 and IV C, as this is a post-Eurasian watermilfoil treatment survey. If approved by the Selectboard, we recommend a sunset date of 10/12/2024.
