

Start:	Farr Rd, behind Mann & Machine
Finish:	Farr Rd, behind Mann & Machine
Distances:	5k turn on Cochran Rd 19'4" west of utility pole #110404
Public spaces requested to close:	Farr Rd east/west and Thompson Rd north/south starting at 8:25 and Cochran Rd east bound only, where the race is occurring, also starting at 8:25 All roads will re-open at 9:15, although some participants may still be on the course.
Other public spaces to be used: Other requests:	Round Church lower parking area Police presence at the start and the turn-around.
