The Town applied for and received an MRGP permit from the State in 2018. The Road Erosion Inventory has been completed with the assistance of the CCRPC. Management plans, capital improvement programs and the formal RSMP will be filed in the coming years pursuant to the requirements of the MRGP which was issued on 1/26/18.
