Town of Richmond mowing bid results and recommendation

The Town property mowing bid was opened on March 4 at 1:00pm with Josh Arneson and myself Pete Gosselin via zoom. The results are as listed. I followed up with the 3 lowest bidders and asked many questions about their bid and ability to perform this work. Prior to reaching out to the contractors I did a cost analysis having done this work for over 25 years knowing exactly the hours needed to do this work. **Contract should cover minimum 60 personnel hours per week times 26 weeks = (1560 hours).** By calculating their bid price by 1560 hours it is very clear that the bid is in line with the work or not.

Guilmette Landworks

\$15.061.18

Divide bid by 1560 = \$9.65 / hr. not including fuel

I spoke with Dylan Guilmette about his price. Dylan was the only contractor that did not call us for a site visit. I questioned his price against the hours needed to perform this work for 26 weeks and he said he just threw a number at the bid and did not realize how much property there really was.

Smith & Sons property service

\$28,080.00

Divide bid by 1560 = \$18 / hr. not including fuel

I spoke with Eric Smith about his bid. He did a site visit but underestimated the hours needed to mow and trim all the Town properties. He estimated 40 hours weekly and after I spoke with him, he realized his bid was too low and appreciated being removed from this project. His crew consists of one full time and two part time people.

Stromme properties

\$38,665.00

Divide bid by 1560 = \$24.78 / hr. not including fuel

I spoke with Mike Stromme about his bid and if he felt confident that he could do this work for this price. He was fine with this price. He has interconnecting properties that allow him to go from the Town properties next door to residential properties as well as the Richmond Elementary school. His crew consists of three mowing crews and 6 people. Mike Stromme is also a Richmond resident and business owner so in my opinion it's in his best interest to do a great job for the Town.

Paquette property services

\$50,167.18

Divide bid by 1560 = \$32.15 / hr. not including fuel

I did not reach out to Isaac Paquette as I feel Stromme properties is the best bid for the Town.
