Each year since I have been a member of the Hale and Hearty Senior Club the town has included in the annual budget \$4100 to help finance our activities. Our club holds monthly meetings with pot luck dinners, and one or two bus trips a year to area attractions for seniors in our community. Most of our expenses are to help subsidize these bus trips. We try to keep the cost to members low so that no one is excluded because of their financial situation.

This year because of the pandemic and because all of our members are in the older more susceptible age group we have suspended all in person activities since early in the year, including our planned trip to Fort Ticonderoga this fall. The money approved in this year's budget will therefore be sufficient for any activities we will plan for next year and we will not be requesting additional funding in next year's budget. We hope that we will again be favorably considered for the funding to be resumed in future years.
