Landscape Maintenance Plan

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April

1. Prune trees and shrubs for winter damage or to maintain proper size of plants.
2. Fertilize species with slow release 5-4-3 organic fertilizer (Pro Grow or Nature's Way)
3. Remove any irrigation materials from previous season.
4. Edge gardens and add mulch to plant beds as needed. Ensure that mulch does not build up against the trunk of trees or shrubs. If mulch depth is more than 4", do not add additional or remove excess before applying new mulch.
5. Prune back any Perennials or Ornamental Grasses that did not get cut back in the fall.
6. Edge gardens

May - September

1. Remove weeds by the root in any garden beds
2. Replace any species that did not survive the winter.
3. Prune any species in years 2 onward after they have flowered.
4. Remove dead flowers on perennials.

October - November

1. Remove weeds by the root in any garden beds
2. Cut back perennials after first hard frost. Allow any ornamental grasses to grow until mid November- December.
3. Blow out garden beds of fallen leaves after foliage season ends.

The landscape maintenance plan only represents maintenance for the existing Building # 1 and Building # 2. This plan doesn't include the Future/optional community garden or Phases 3 or 4.
