Here are some examples of existing projects:

Masonry

- Repointing brickwork along the Town Center entrance
- Pressure washing, cleaning, possible painting of brick façade around Bulletin Board
- Mitigate or Repair cinder block degradation beside Post Office ramp

Roofing/Gutter/General Maintenance

- Repair down spout in front of Post Office
- Repair roof and ceiling leaks of Post Office
- Repair fascia and pads of dock bay of Post Office
- Repair ceiling tiles in Post Office and Town Center entrance

Cleaning/Painting/Refurbishing

- Bulletin board display case at Town Center entrance
- Bike rack at Town Center entrance
- Wooden bench outside of Post Office entrance
- Painting walls of entryway and stairwell

Carpet/Flooring

- Replace old carpets at Town Center entrance with carpet or flooring
- Provide solutions for minimizing tracking of rain, mud, snow
