

Williston VT 2A and Industrial Ave Project [Williston STP 5500(17)]

DATE: Friday, August 1, 2025

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: From Monday, August 4, through Friday, August 8, between 6:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., the VT 2A southbound right-turn-only lane at the Industrial Avenue intersection will be intermittently closed. Alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers may be in effect at the intersection of VT 2A and Industrial Avenue between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Throughout the week, Industrial Avenue between Gail Terrace and VT 2A will be reduced to a single lane with alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Motorists should expect significant daytime delays throughout the week and are encouraged to allow extra travel time or consider alternate routes.


Drivers should slow down, use caution, and follow flaggers and road signs.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Crews are installing a traffic signal conduit sleeve across the north side of VT 2A at Industrial Avenue this week, with work possibly extending into early next week.

Next week, crews will also install temporary pedestrian access routes and begin curb work on Industrial Avenue, including prep work, installation, and patch paving up to the back of the curb.

LOCATION: The project limits (highlighted in orange above) include the 0.7-mile segment of Vermont Route 2A (VT 2A) in Williston, VT from Meadowrun Road to just south of River Cove Road, including its intersection with Industrial Avenue/Mountain View Road.
