



Construction Update

Williston VT 2A and Industrial Ave Project [Williston STP 5500(17)]

DATE: Friday, September 18, 2026

TRAFFIC IMPACT AND DURATION: Major traffic delays are expected next week on Vermont Route 2A (VT 2A) due to final paving operations. Drivers should allow extra travel time.

From Monday, September 21, through Friday, September 25, 6 a.m. to 12 p.m.:

- Industrial Avenue between the pedestrian bridge over Allen Brook and VT 2A will be closed to through traffic. Access to local residences and businesses will be maintained via Industrial Avenue from the west (near N Brownell Road). Signed detours will be posted via U.S. Route 2 and VT 2A. *Please note that the temporary closure of Industrial Avenue will facilitate final paving for this project as well as additional paving work the contractor is completing on behalf of the Town of Williston.*
- Mountain View Road between Marions Way and VT 2A will be closed to through traffic. Access to local residences and businesses will be maintained via Mountain View Road from the east (near Marions Way). Signed detours will be posted via North Williston Road, U.S. 2, and VT 2A.

From 12 p.m. to 3 p.m., Industrial Avenue between Gail Terrace and VT 2A and Mountain View Road between Marions Way and VT 2A may periodically have single-lane closures with alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers.

From 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., VT 2A between Meadowrun Road and River Cove Road will have lane shifts, with two-way traffic predominately maintained. There is potential for periodic alternating one-way traffic controlled by flaggers from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. if needed.

Intersecting side streets and driveways along VT 2A, Industrial Avenue, and Mountain View Road in the project area will experience brief, temporary access interruptions as paving operations pass. Access interruptions are anticipated on the east side of VT 2A on Monday, on the west side of VT 2A on Wednesday, and on Industrial Avenue/Mountain View Road on Thursday and Friday. This schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Milled surfaces are present. Drivers should slow down, use caution, and follow directions from flaggers and posted signage.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES: Next week, crews will complete final paving on:

- VT 2A between Meadowrun Road and River Cove Road;
- Industrial Avenue between Gail Terrace and VT 2A; and
- Mountain View Road between Marions Way and VT 2A.

Final paving will take place on VT 2A Monday through Wednesday, before shifting to Industrial Avenue and Mountain View Road later in the week. VT 2A paving will progress from south to north each day. Paving activities are weather dependent. Crews will also begin installing permanent roadway signage along VT 2A mid-week.

LOCATION: The project limits (highlighted in orange above) include the 0.7-mile segment of Vermont Route 2A (VT 2A) in Williston, VT from Meadowrun Road to just south of River Cove Road, including its intersection with Industrial Avenue/Mountain View Road.
