Williston VT 2A and Industrial Ave Project [Williston STP 5500(17)]


PROJECT UPDATE: Construction activities for the Williston VT 2A and Industrial Avenue Project are scheduled to begin for the 2026 construction season the week of March 30, 2026.

Throughout the 2026 season, crews will complete roadway widening and reconstruction along Vermont Route 2A from the Industrial Avenue/Mountain View Road intersection north to just south of River Cove Road. Work will include installing stormwater treatment systems, completing sewer improvements, placing final paving and line striping, installing permanent signage, rehabilitating drainage inlets, catch basins, and manholes, and finishing curbs, sidewalks, traffic signals, streetlights, and landscaping throughout the project limits.

Construction hours will generally take place Monday through Friday, from 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Traffic impacts will include lane shifts and lane reductions, with alternating one-way traffic during off-peak hours. Periods of significant traffic delays are expected during lane reductions due to existing high-traffic volumes on VT 2A, and drivers are encouraged to allow extra travel time or consider alternate routes.

The project team will resume weekly Construction Updates via email on March 27 and continue throughout the season, outlining anticipated work activities and traffic impacts for the upcoming week. Schedules may change due to weather, subcontractor availability, or field conditions, and Traffic Alerts will be issued ahead of major traffic changes.

The Williston VT 2A and Industrial Avenue Project is expected to be completed in fall 2026.



LOCATION: The project limits (highlighted in orange above) include the 0.7-mile segment of Vermont Route 2A (VT 2A) in Williston, VT from Meadowrun Road to just south of River Cove Road, including its intersection with Industrial Avenue/Mountain View Road.
