

Pharmacy definitions proposed for 1.4.23 (Gateway R/C)

Pharmacy, Large Scale -- a business establishment whose primary activity is the sale, compounding and dispensing of drugs and medications and whose total gross floor area is greater than 5,000 square feet. Medications and health products may be over the counter or by physicians' prescriptions, and are overseen by a licensed pharmacist. Customary accessory uses may include the sale of personal products or other accessories. No more than 2% of the gross floor area shall be devoted to the sale of food items, which are limited to snacks and beverages. . Establishments selling cannabis products shall not be considered pharmacies

Pharmacy, Village Scale -- a business establishment whose primary activity is the sale, compounding and dispensing of drugs and medications and whose total gross floor area is less than or equal to 5,000 square feet. Medications and health products may be over the counter or by physicians' prescriptions, and are overseen by a licensed pharmacist. Customary accessory uses may include the sale of other health and wellness products. No more than 2% of the gross floor area shall be devoted to the sale of food items, which are limited to snacks and beverages. . Establishments selling cannabis products shall not be considered pharmacies.
