

Retail, large-scale – An establishment primarily engaged in selling or renting merchandise, except foods, to the general public, whose total gross floor area is greater than 5,000 square feet. This use does not include the sale of automobiles or boats (see Automobile and/or Marine Sales), sales of wood products (see Lumber Yard), sales of medications (see Pharmacy), and sales of foods (see Grocery Store, Large Scale).

Retail, village-scale – An establishment primarily engaged in selling or renting merchandise, except foods, to the general public, whose total gross floor area is equal to or less than 5,000 square feet. This use does not include the sale of automobiles or boats (see Automobile and/or Marine Sales), sales of wood products (see Lumber Yard), sales of medications (see Pharmacy), and sales of foods (see Grocery Store, Village Scale).
