I am writing to request that Green Mountain Athletic Association have permission to hold the 43rd Annual Round Church Women's Run again this year. Details are listed below. As we did last year, we will maintain practices consistent with the most current Covid 19-related social policies and practices. We are currently planning an in-person event. Again this year, we plan to offer only the shorter 5k distance this year. This will allow us to be more nimble in case we need to change our plans due to any new advice from public health officials. We feel grateful to have been able to host this event that benefits the physical and mental health of so many members of our community for so many seasons now.

As required by the Town of Richmond Charitable Event Policy, this is an event that benefits Girls on the Run. In addition to providing them with a financial contribution from the proceeds of our race registrations, this run offers young runners an opportunity to see role models coming out to race. 
