Suit reasons continued

- 5 Snow plowing trespass, elevated slip fall risk, increase of impervious surface. Defendants could easily mitigate and cure by implementing ANR GIS GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE SYSTEMS and are deliberately not following best practices.
