

- Established by voters 2005
- Last Renewed by voters 2023 (Yes 560; No 201)
- Has brought in over \$1.8 Million in outside support

A 19-year successful track record at protecting water and air quality, biodiversity, working farms and forests, outdoor recreation, historic resources and education.

- Enables the Town to move quickly to capture prime, time-sensitive funding opportunities.
- Brings in major support from outside funding sources (State, Federal, foundations)


