The Chittenden County Regional Planning Commission (CCRPC), in partnership with the Town of Richmond, invites you to attend the Draft Alternatives Meeting of the Cochran Road Corridor Study (Study). The purpose of the Study is to develop and identify a recommended alternative for Cochran Road that improves safety, comfort, and mobility for non-motorized users along the corridor and to expand access to recreational sites based on public feedback. The Study will identify potential infrastructure treatments at the Village ends in Richmond and Jonesville and multimodal strategies and improvements along the Cochran Road corridor. The goal of this meeting is to gather public input on an array of potential treatments and strategies to help inform the Study Team's recommendation of a preferred solution for further refinement.

The Draft Alternatives Meeting will include a presentation that reviews the Purpose and Need of the Study and outlines potential alternatives and high-level anticipated costs followed by a community discussion. The public is encouraged to attend and participate in this meeting. We invite you to share your concerns, opinions, and ideas to inform the selection and development of a preferred alternative for the Village ends and Cochran Road corridor that meets the community's needs.
