## Good afternoon,

The Chittenden County Regional Planning Commission (CCRPC) has undertaken an update to its Bylaws (*last amended April 19, 2017*) prompted by updated Census data and the recommended changes outlined in <u>this memo</u>. CCRPC's Board Development Committee <u>met</u> four times in 2024 to review the <u>existing Bylaws</u>, propose edits, and recommend a revised version to the CCRPC Board. At its meeting on February 19, 2025, the CCRPC Board decided to move the draft Bylaws forward to be reviewed by municipalities. Following this review and comment period, CCRPC will summarize any comments received and follow the process outlined in <u>Article X. Adoptions or Amendments – A. Bylaws (page 9</u>).
