Huntington Gorge / Dugway Rd Parking Rules



- It's best to park only on one side of the road
- Do not try to "squeeze in" at the end of a line of cars
- · Do not leave valuables in your car
- No parking in front of the upper gorge at all (there are signs)
- Do not park up on the embankment, that is someone's property.

Regular Parking Violation: \$25 fine Impeding the flow of traffic: \$200+ fine Towing your locked, in park vehicle plus storage/yard fees: \$200 & up
