49 Clarke illustrated the timeline for adoption: 50 -Planning Commission Public Hearing on November 19 51 -Selectboard Public Hearing in early January to vote to accept 52 -Placed on Ballot and warned by January 22 53 -Town-wide vote to adopt on March 3 54 55 The overview of the Body Plan/Sections is listed as: 56 1. Utilities, Facilities and Public Safety - Clarke 67 68 Heston asked if ADUs being on municipal water and sewer is a State mandate. Oborne 69 stated that the State mandate to be on public water and sewer is to have a fifth of an acre 70 of zoning with other issues that are dealt with in Act 181 71 (https://legislature.vermont.gov/Documents/2024/Docs/ACTS/ACT181/ACT181%20As 72 %20Enacted.pdf). 73 74 Clarke confirmed that you can build an ADU anywhere. The only restrictions the 75 Planning Commission is considering changing is the way an ADU was originally 76 conceived, like a mother-in-law apartment. 77 78 Clarke welcomed everyone to stick around for desserts or to ask personal questions. 79 80 Adjourn 81 82 Filkins moved to adjourn.
