The video inspection revealed slight bellying in some of the clay tile however we feel by bursting through the old pipe the HDPE should obtain adequate pitch and will be a large upgrade compared to the existing line.

Option #2 – Excavate and trench full line from front of building to city main and replace with 4” SDR35 pipe - \$29,750.00
