History and Purpose


The Richmond Transportation Committee

- Created in 2019
- Charged with developing a town <u>Transportation Implementation</u>
 <u>Plan</u> with projects selected based on community input, feasibility studies and current cost estimates.
- The Transportation Plan will support the Town Plan and the regional plan and will promote public health and safety while seeking to avoid and minimize environmental impacts.
- The Transportation Committee will reach its goal using a process that encourages and incorporates participation from stakeholders and community members.

GOAL: Strengthen the town's vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian network by...

- Investing in planning, scoping, engineering and construction of new facilities (ex. roads, sidewalks, paths, traffic calming measures) and of improvements to existing facilities.
- Supporting the building out of facilities to fill gaps in the town's infrastructure network.
- Monitoring and evaluating roads for their efficiency and safety for all users.
