# History and Purpose

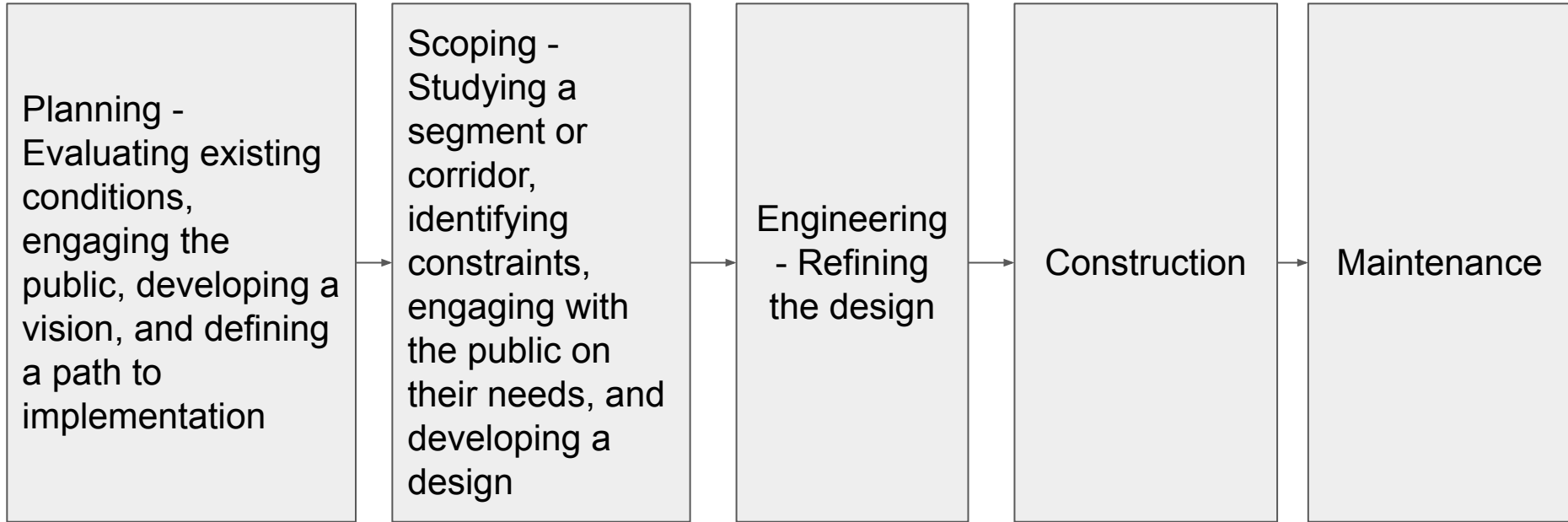
## The Richmond Transportation Committee

- Created in 2019
- Charged with developing a town [Transportation Implementation Plan](#) with projects selected based on community input, feasibility studies and current cost estimates.
- The Transportation Plan will support the Town Plan and the regional plan and will promote public health and safety while seeking to avoid and minimize environmental impacts.
- The Transportation Committee will reach its goal using a process that encourages and incorporates participation from stakeholders and community members.

**GOAL:** Strengthen the town's vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian network by...

- Investing in planning, scoping, engineering and construction of new facilities (ex. roads, sidewalks, paths, traffic calming measures) and of improvements to existing facilities.
- Supporting the building out of facilities to fill gaps in the town's infrastructure network.
- Monitoring and evaluating roads for their efficiency and safety for all users.

# Priority Items

- Continued support of the construction of sidewalks on the east side of Bridge Street, and pedestrian safety improvements along Bridge Street
  - This would entail build out of sidewalks and improvements per the Richmond Sidewalks Scoping Study and the Bridge Street complete Streets Corridor Study.
  - These projects are already in the Capital Plan and Budget as “Bridge Street Redesign”
