Josh, Please see attached an Excel Workbook which contains esite locations, businesses, and CCRPC housing points which are within the existing water/sewer service area.

As mentioned when we spoke on the phone, the business data is from ESRI. If you want more information about the data source, see here. Also the business data does not show complete addresses as the address number is not included. There may be holes in the data because it's a national datasource. For example, The Big Spruce restaurant is not included. If you find the business data not reliable, I suggest using the non-residential e911 locations. You can find these from the esite location tab and filter the SITETYPE column for commercial and other non-residential uses.

The Housing data is CCRPC's unique dataset that we update each year from approved certificate of occupancy data we collect from municipalities. The housing data contains the number of units at each address. You will notice that the esite data also has units at each location. I can't speak to the accuracy of the e911 units I just notice that there are some differences between what we show for units at each location. Keep in mind that if a housing unit says its multiunit and the dwelling unit count column (DUCount) says its 1 it is because it has a unique address and is likely an attached housing unit.
